FOGG POINT SYSTEM

The Fogg report is named for Josiah Fogg, who was the first official member of the Missouri State SAR. His State Number is 001 and his National Number is 3801. He lived from 1824-1901 and died in St. Louis. Early records identify him as the founder of the Missouri Society, SAR. He was the first President of the Missouri Society, SAR, serving from 1889-1890 and 1890-1891. Because of all this, the Fogg Report is strictly a Missouri SAR report.

Many of the items listed on the Fogg Report are also on the Americanism/ President General Form about which another list of point activities has been generation.

For the Fogg report, the chapter gets points the following ways:

AREA 1: MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Each new member: 100 points each for up to 1000 points
- 2. Each approved Supplemental App: 25 points each for up to 250 points
- 3. Each reinstatement: 50 points each for up to 300 points
- 4. Percentage of dues paid by Oct 1 of dues year: 1 point per percentage
- 5. Percentage of dues paid by Nov 1 of dues year: 1 point per percentage
- 6. Percentage of dues paid by Dec 1 of dues year: 1 point per percentage (for 4-6, the numbers accumulate, meaning people that pay by October 1 actually get the chapter 4 points (10/1; 11/; 12/1)
- 7. People who are Life Members—National—25 points each; 250 points max
- 8. People who are Life Members—State—10 points each; 100 points max

AREA 2: CONTRIBUTIONS

- 1. Charitable funds to MOSSAR Funds (patriots, general): 1 point per dollar; 500 pints max
- 2. Charitable funds to National funds (George Washington Endowment Funds, etc; 1 point per dollar; 250 max
- 3. Charitable contributions to Children of Am Revolution: 1 point per dollar; 100 max
- 4. Donations of an SAR book or magazine to a library: 15 points each, 150 max
- 5. Donation of an appropriate book (genealogy, etc) to the NSSAR Library: 25 points each, 100 max

AREA 3: ATTENDANCE

- 1. Percentage attendance at monthly meetings—average number of persons attending monthly meetings divided by the number of members at the end of the calendar year (2018 we got 25 points for this—many of our members live out of state so cannot make it due to distance)
- 2. For each chapter member attending National Congress: 25 points; 100 max
- 3. For each chapter member attending the State Annual Convention: 20 points; 300 max (we have 15 signed up this year 15x20=300)
- 4. For each chapter member attending a State Board Meeting: 15 points; 300 max
- 5. For each chapter member attending a District meeting: 15 points; 60 max

AREA 4: PUBLICITY

- 1. Coverage of monthly Chapter activities by newspaper, radio, TV or magazine: 15 points for each month; 180 max points
- 2. For each Chapter webpage or Facebook link on non-SAR website, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn mentioned per month: 15 points; 300 max
- 3. For each advertisement in the SAR Magazine, Missouri Compatriot, or Missouri Convention Booklet; 15 points; 150 max
- 4. For each article by a Chapter member published in the Missouri Compatriot or SAR Magazine; 25 points; 200 max
- 5. Speeches, which publicize the SAR, given by a Chapter member to a Non-SAR activity; 25 points; 100 max (the is Speakers Bureau)
- 6. Maintenance of a Chapter Yearbook; 150 points
- 7. Internet Web Site; 10 points per Web page (6-page max) 5 points per link to other appropriate Web sites (8 links max); 100 max—we max this every year thanks to J.Y.!
- 8. Chapter Color Guard; 50 points for chapter sponsorship, 250 points for activities. (5 points per man per activity). 300 points max
- 9. Chapter Color Guard submittal for an edition of the NSSAR The SAR Color guardsman; 25 points each event up to 4 events. 100 max points

AREA 5: CONTESTS & AWARDS

- 1. Participation in the Eagle Scout Program; One (1) point for each package delivered to an Eagle Scout. Max of 50—we always get this
- 2. Chapter's Eagle Scout Winner submitted for State Competition; 50 points.
- 3. Holding a Chapter Oration Contest. If it is publicized at local schools, you can take 50 points, even if there are no entries. In other words, send a letter to schools and get 50 points even with no reply. I have done this the last two years. If we get a reply we would need to judge.
- 4. Providing state with an Oratorical Contestant; 50 points.
- 5. Presentation of SAR Medals/Awards, as Set forth in the SAR Handbook, to non-SAR persons; 25 points each; 200 max
- 6. Presentation of SAR Medals to SAR Members; 10 points each. 100 points max
- 7. Participation in a JROTC/ROTC Awards Ceremony; 25 points each. 100 points max
- 8. Holding a Chapter Essay Contest. If it is publicized at local schools, you can take 50 points, even if there are no entries. I did this the last two years. No reply.
- 9. Providing State with a Knight Essay Contestant; 50 points.
- 10. Providing state with a M. Graham Clark Teacher of the Year Contestant High School; 50 points.
- 11. Providing state with a M. Graham Clark Teacher of the Year Contestant elementary School; 50 points.
- 12. Holding a Chapter SAR Poster Contest; 10 Points per entry. 50 points max
- 13. Holding a Chapter SAR Pamphlet/Brochure Contest; 10 Points per entry. 50 points max.

AREA 6: DISPLAYS

- 1. For each Revolutionary War Patriot Grave in Missouri that is properly marked with the SAR Emblem; 50 points. 250 max points
- 2. For each SAR Grave in Missouri that is properly marked with the SAR Emblem; 50 points. 100 max points
- 3. For each Grave marking ceremony conducted in conjunction with A and B above; 50 points. 250 max points
- 4. For each ceremony and certificate presented to a company or an individual
- 5. for the proper display of the United States Flag; 25 points. 250 max points
- 6. Display booths/tables setup at Library, Fairs, Genealogical conferences, etc.; 50 points each. 200 points max

AREA 7: PROGRAMS

- 1. For each monthly program provided by: A non-chapter member; 15 points. A Chapter member, 10 points. 180 max points
- 2. Special ceremonies. (i.e. Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Flag Day,
- 3. July 4 th , Funeral Ritual/Memorial Service etc.); 50 points each. 150 max points
- 4. Joint meeting with the DAR; 50 points. 50 points max
- 5. Sponsoring a New SAR Chapter; 100 points.
- 6. Chapter members currently holding a State Office; 25 points each member. 100 points max
- 7. Chapter members who are currently State Committee Chairman/Members; 15 points. 90 points max
- 8. SAR/CAR joint activities; 20 points each. 60 max points
- 9. SAR adult commitment to CAR; 10 points each SAR member e.g. Officer or Chairman at local, state, national levels. 100 max points
- 10. CAR Fund raiser Participation; 50 points for hosting a fund raiser for CAR.
