The popular Christmas Carol was written as a poem in 1816 by Austrian priest Joseph Mohr. Schoolmaster Franz Xaver Gruber composed the melody in 1818 and the two performed the composition for the first time that Christmas.

Pictures of the scenic church and its replacement were displayed, along with a picture of the memorial dedicated to the two men who composed one of the world's most popular Christmas songs.
