Minutes of Meeting 22 February 2025

The original date of the meeting was moved ahead 7 days due to inclement weather which has persisted in below freezing temperatures for 3 weeks. The meeting this day was called to order by President Alan Hiles at 9:00 a.m. in the Memorial Room of American Legion Post 202 located at 3669 Legion Lane, Columbia, MO 65201: http://americanlegionpost202.org/

At 9:07, President Hiles announced a break for breakfast served in the ballroom. The menu was scrambled eggs, sausage, pancakes, biscuits and gravy, and beverages for \$12, and paid individually by members. President Hiles reconvened the meeting at 9:40 a.m.

COM Robert Bartlett is recovering from the removal of a kidney stone and pneumonia. The members signed a card wishing him a rapid recovery and good health.

Randall Palmer was inducted as a member of the Sons of the American Revolution. COM Palmer was sworn in by M. Graham Clark Chapter President Hiles and sponsored by COM Coutts.

The program consisted of nomination, election, and swearing in of officers. The 50-50 drawing, drawn by COM Merrill, for \$6 was won by COM Raymond Miller who donated his winnings to the Chapter treasury.

Historian Charles Lee requested members provide him with any old Chapter records in their possession for consolidation.

The March 15, 2025 meeting program will be a presentation by State President Gene Henry. The April 18, 2025 meeting program will be a presentation by COM Luke Lucas concerning the Boston Massacre. The May 17, 2025 meeting will be a presentation by COM Mitchell Moore on the U. S. Constitution.

Outgoing President Alan Hiles thanked officers and members for their support during his 2-year term and then presented to incoming President Hank Hammons the gavel, presidential medal and lanyard.

President Hammons thanked COM Hiles and asked for final business by the members.

Thereafter, there followed a discussion of the protocol for the wearing of medals and the rosette, the color of the presidential lanyards, and the like with the general consensus being that a program on such may be warranted in the future.
