At 9:05, President Hiles announced a break for breakfast served in the ballroom. The menu was scrambled eggs, hash browns, sausage, bacon, scones and muffins, fruit, and beverages for \$12, and paid individually by members.

President Hiles reconvened the meeting at 9:40 a.m.

President Hiles had a birthday on January 12.

The 39th President of the United States, Jimmy Carter, died on December 29, 2024. President Carter was a member of the SAR.

President Alan Hiles gave a presentation on James Reese Europe and the Harlem Hellfighters.

An early Ragtime band leader at the turn of the century, Europe played multiple times at Carnegie Hall and helped popularize "Negro" music and earned the title "Jazz King".

Lieutenant James Reese Europe was also the first African-American to lead troops in combat, the "Harlem Hellfighters," who served with distinction in France and popularized American music on the Continent.

COM J. Y. Miller moved, and COM David Bartlett seconded that the slate of officers for next year be to be voted on during the February meeting. They are as follows:

COM Paul Whatley declined to serve as Executive Secretary. COM Terrell Stamps was nominated for the office of Executive Secretary and the revised slate was approved

The membership will vote on the new slate of officers at the February 15, 2025 meeting.

The March 15, 2025 meeting program will be a presentation by State President Gene Henry.
